

Finishing: Sashing and Border (provided November 2016; share December 2016)

The sashing and border have cornerstones to add a little interest. As shown, four Fabrics are used: Light, Medium, Dark, Darkest.

Fabric needed: Cut the listed pieces for each fabric. Be sure each piece is cut accurately.

Piecing Instructions for 9" blocks (3", 6", 12", 15")

Light	20 at 1" x 1"	20 at 1-1/2" x 1-1/2"	20 at 2" x 2"	20 at 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"	20 at 3" x 3"
Medium	4 at 1-3/4" x 1-3/4"	4 at 3" x 3"	4 at 4-1/4" x 4-1/4"	4 at 5-1/2" x 5-1/2"	4 at 6-3/4" x 6-3/4"
Dark	31 at 1" x 3-1/2"	31 at 1-1/2" x 6-1/2"	31 at 2" x 9-1/2"	31 at 2-1/2" x 12-1/2"	31 at 3" x 15-1/2"
Darkest	2 at 1-3/4" x 11-1/2" 2 at 1-3/4" x 15"	2 at 3" x 22-1/2" 2 at 3" x 29-1/2"	2 at 4-1/4" x 33-1/2" 2 at 4-1/4" x 44"	2 at 5-1/2" x 44-1/2" 2 at 58-1/2"	2 at 6-3/4" x 55-1/2" 2 at 6-3/4" x 73"

1. Stitch five sashing rows using 1/4" seams. Each row has 4 (four) Light squares alternating with 3 (three) Dark strips. Press the seams toward the Dark strips. The rows will measure 2" x 33-1/2" (1" x 11-1/2", 1-1/2" x 22-1/2", 2-1/2" x 44-1/2", 3" x 55-1/2").
2. Stitch four block rows. Each block row has 4 (four) Dark strips alternating with 3 (three) blocks. Arrange the blocks in any order that pleases you. Press the seams toward the Dark strips. The rows will measure 9-1/2" x 33-1/2" (3-1/2" x 11-1/2", 6-1/2" x 22-1/2", 12-1/2" x 44-1/2", 15-1/2" x 55-1/2")

Provided layout by row:

Log Cabin	Three by Two	Spools
Shoofly	Twin Star	Card Trick
Dutchman's Puzzle	Monkey Wrench	Double Pinwheel
True Lover's Knot	French Silk Pie	An Album Block

3. Sew the rows together alternating sashing rows with block rows. The seams should nest. Press the seams in any direction. The combined rows should measure 33-1/2" x 44" (11-1/2" x 15", 22-1/2" x 29-1/2", 44-1/2" x 58-1/2", 55-1/2" x 73").
4. Sew a longer Darkest strip to either side. (Piece together as needed.)
5. Sew a Medium square to each end of the shorter Darkest strips.
6. Sew the border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Your quilt should measure 41" x 51-1/2" (14" x 17-1/2", 27-1/2" x 34-1/2", 54-1/2" x 68-1/2", 68" x 85-1/2").
7. All that is left is to layer, quilt, bind and label your project.
